The CT Behavioral Health Partnership (CT BHP) is a partnership among:

- Department of Social Services (DSS),
- Department of Children and Families (DCF),
- Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS).

Carelon BH CT serves as the Partnership's Administrative Service Organization (ASO).

In addition, we work closely with the Department of Developmental Services (DDS).

- For Youth: DCF residential care, intensive home-based services, PRTF, child state inpatient care, autism services, Solnit QM
- For Adults: Outpatient, Inpatient, IOP/PHP, Detox (Withdrawal Management)



Serves all children & families in CT regardless of insurance

Contracts: Direct to State; Served approx 9,450 in FY 2022

Program Offerings:

- ACCESS Mental Health: Psychiatric consultative support for providers of youth to age 22 and perinatal moms.
- CT Network of Care Transformation (CONNECT) grant to bridge gaps in service/support integrated system of care.
- Intensive Care Coordination helps families/youth through age 18 with complex BH challenges at risk of congregate care to remain in their homes and communities.
- Integrated Family Care & Support connects high need families (unsubstantiated after DCF Care Line referral) to needed services via modified Wraparound approach.
- **Voluntary Care Management** connects children and youth to high needs BH services that they have had difficulty accessing.

Autism Spec Disorders Pro (ASD)	Care Coordinators and Peers help family gather documentation to confirm eligibility for ASD program. Support families and member facing barriers to coordination of care specific to ABA services.	Members with HUSKY A, C, and D under the age of 21 can receive evaluation, behavior assessment and treatment services. -An Autism Diagnostic Evaluation (ADE) demonstrating the assessment tools used resulting in a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ADOS, ADI-R, CARS, GARS) completed by Licensed Clinician, MD, APRN or Licensed Psychologist is required. -If the ADE was completed more that a year ago, a letter by the current treating provider is required to support an ASD diagnosis. -Release of Information for all providers is required. -Any HUSKY member diagnosed with autism or seeking an autism evaluation is eligible to receive support from an ASD Care Coordinator or Peer.  services are medically necessary.


Effective July 1, 2016, Carelon BH CT

Carelon BH CT ASD Care Coordinators & Peer Specialists

- Available to HUSKY Health eligible individuals regardless of HUSKY benefit package or age.
- May be utilized to guide families through the process of accessing Medicaid funded ASD services and/or other community-based services.
- Care Coordinators and Peer Specialists are regionally assigned and have experience navigating the system.
- Are trained in Wraparound Care Coordination for those families who require a higher level of support.



Navigating Connection to Care: Step-By-Step

Diagnostic Evaluation

Step

- Medical Evaluation
- Standardized Testing tools
- Autism Diagnostic Testing
- Adaptive Functioning Evaluation
- Completed by licensed clinician

Behavior Assessment

Determines the reasons or functions of the behavior and the factors that maintain it.

Treatment Plan

- Identifies and defines behaviors
- Outlines measurable, observable goals for behaviors to decrease and skills to increase





Required to access insurance based or state-funded services

Connecticut BHP

Upporfing Health and Recovery

- **ASK QUESTIONS**
- Direct observations in multiple locations
- Provider should review consents to assess and treat, HIPAA requirements and releases of information and request guardian signature
- Final Plan should be reviewed and signed off indicating you, the guardian understand and agree

- The information in this plan is used to inform the number of clinical hours recommended for treatment and supports the medical necessity for the intervention
- Final Plan should be reviewed and signed off indicating you, the guardian, understand and agree

Navigating Connection to Care: Direct Treatment

Direct Intervention

- Can be delivered 1:1 or in a group setting
- In-home
- In-community
- Follows the treatment plan developed by BCBA which outlines measurable and observable goals
- Data-driven

Goals

- To transfer skills to family/caregivers
- To decrease interfering behaviors
- To increase skill acquisition

Clinical Oversight

"The amount of supervision for each case must be responsive to individual client needs... [The] ratio of case supervision hours to direct treatment hours reflects the complexity of the client's ASD symptoms and the responsive, individualized, data-based decision-making which characterizes [behavioral] treatment."

- May not duplicate services through the school


